

## **Michener's Expedited Full-Time MRI Program - January 2023 Intake FAQ**

### Admissions

<p>1. What is the application deadline for the full-time Magnetic Resonance Imaging 2<sup>nd</sup> Discipline (MRI Expedited) program January 2023 intake?</p> <p>a. Applicants must apply and submit all <a href="#">supporting documents</a> by November 18, 2022.</p>
<p>2. How do I apply for the January 2023 intake?</p> <p>a. Apply on Michener's Self Service: <a href="https://students.michener.ca/PowerCampusSelfService/Admissions/ApplicationForm/7">https://students.michener.ca/PowerCampusSelfService/Admissions/ApplicationForm/7</a></p>
<p>3. Do I need to re-submit my application if I applied for the September intake?</p> <p>a. Yes, those who have applied for the September intake of the MRI program are required to submit a new application for the January 2023 expedited intake.</p> <p>b. Those who are currently enrolled in the part-time MRI program are also required to submit a new application for the January 2023 intake as there is limited capacity for transfer students.</p>
<p>4. What are the admission requirements?</p> <p>a. <p>5. When will I hear a decision on my application?</p> <p>a. Offers will be sent out by December 5, 2022.</p>
<p>6. What is the deadline to accept my offer of admission and to pay my fees?</p> <p>a. Successful candidates for the January intake must accept their offer of admission by December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and pay tuition fees by December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022.</p>

## Finances

### 1. What will the program cost?

### 2. Can I apply for financial aid and scholarships?

- a. No, students enrolled in the full-time MRI Expedited program are not eligible for the Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) or Michener student bursaries.

## Program Delivery

### 1. Will the January intake be an accelerated program?

- a. Yes, the January intake will be a full-time program – a total of two semesters, as follows:

*\*upon successful completion, graduates will be eligible to challenge Canadian Association of Medical Radiation Technologists (CAMRT) MRI certification examination in September 2023 – please refer to [CAMRT website](#) for more information on exam sitting dates, registration period and fees.*

### 2. Will courses be delivered online or in-person?

- a. Didactic courses will be delivered online in both synchronous and asynchronous formats. Students are expected to attend all courses and actively participate in the online synchronous sessions (course schedule will be available soon).
- b. Clinical begins with a mandatory four-day Clinical Readiness component (half day at Michener, rest delivered online in both synchronous and asynchronous formats), followed by a 14 week full-time clinical practicum.

<p>3. Can I continue to work full time while taking this program?</p> <p>a. No, as this is a full-time program, you must be able to commit to a minimum of 21 hours/week in the first semester and 35 hours/week in the second semester.</p>
<p>4. What will the class size be for January?</p> <p>a. There will be a minimum of 12 students and maximum of 16 students in the January cohort.</p>
<p>5. Is the program designed to go at your own pace?</p> <p>a. No, there is a set order to the courses and timelines. Each course has a weekly schedule with fixed start and end dates and structured deadlines for assessments that students will need to follow.</p>
<p>6. Can I do my clinical on a part-time basis?</p> <p>a. No, the clinical practicum can only be completed on a full-time basis. Full time means 8-hour shifts 5 days per week.</p>
