Position Description:

The Chiroprapist is a primary health care practitioner and a member of the Health Services Team and works closely with team members to provide foot care services to clients. The Chiroprapist provides services at nine (9) Community Health Centres on a rotational basis.

The successful candidate is required to provide services at the Rideau Community Health Services (Merrickville, Ontario) site one day per week as part of the position.

Hours of work will be developed in collaboration with the successful candidate to ensure a healthy work-life balance. A schedule of work will be based on the Centre's hours of operation and program requirements and may include some evenings.
