- Skill transfer and/or peer mentoring

- Vascular, Musculoskeletal and Obstetrical (including NT scanning) experience preferred
- Experience with Cerner and GEPACS software suites considered a strong asset
- Current Police Check/Vulnerable Sector Screen and immunization status required upon hire.
